Treasurer's Report - Draft

The accounts are put together on a very straight forward receipts and payments basis. That is, they represent what was actually paid into and out of the bank account during the year 2021.

This year the pandemic continued to limit activities and no GBDSC events were held during the year. The club rolled over 2020 membership fees (£1850) and Gala fees (£930) paid to 2021, £2780 in total.

The club has incurred a few costs to keep the club going, but these have been kept to a minimum. These were Swim England memberships for committee members so they could continue to act for the club. A subscription was made to UK Deaf Sport in 2021 to facilitate some self-funding members of the club to participate in the Poland Short Course Championships.

The club has been very fortunate to have been offered a monthly donation from a former swimmer with GBDSC who wishes to remain anonymous. The club also received a one-off donation.

Judith Simpson, a former swimmer with the club, checked the financial accounts are in line with the requirements of the club's constitution for 2020 and has agreed to do the same for 2021 accounts. She has very generously offered her services for free.
